

Education Support Services

Background:

Education in Bangladesh faces several challenges, especially for underprivileged communities. Poor access to educational materials, insufficient school infrastructure, and lack of opportunities for teachers to improve their skills significantly affect the quality of education. This program aims to bridge these gaps and provide vital support for students and teachers, fostering an environment conducive to learning and development.

Importance of the Program:

This program is designed to ensure equitable access to education for vulnerable children, improve academic outcomes, and enhance the capacity of teachers. By addressing the needs of both students and teachers, the program contributes to the broader goal of achieving Sustainable Development Goal 4: ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education for all.

Major Components & Budget Allocation (5 Year-Program)

1. **Academic Stationery Distribution**
Providing academic supplies such as books, notebooks, and other essential items to 10,000 students annually.
2. **Monthly Stipends for Meritorious Students**
Offering a stipend of \$500 per year to 500 high-achieving students.
3. **Teacher Training Workshops**
Organizing 100 workshops over five years, benefiting 3,000 teachers, improving their teaching skills and methods.
4. **School Infrastructure and Furniture**
Providing necessary school infrastructure and furniture for vulnerable schools to ensure a comfortable learning environment.
